Fund the Mortgage Foreclosure Prevention Initiative: \$1,250,000

We'll work to stop homeowners from losing their homes to foreclosure by working with community-based organizations to provide foreclosure prevention services and by conducting advocacy with lenders.

- We'll serve 2,000 homeowners, and reach about 10,000 in total.
- Existing initiative funded at \$1,000,000, seeking an additional \$250,000.

Fund the Homeowner Tax Help Initiative: \$500,000

Too many homeowners are overburdened by taxes. We'll partner with the Council and community-based organizations to ensure that homeowners are prepared to navigate the new federal tax landscape, obtain exemptions and stay off the City's tax lien sale list.

- We'll conduct outreach to 6,000 homeowners.
